
This letter is in regards to the State's section 1115 Health Insurance Flexibility and Accountability (HIFA) demonstration, which was approved on November 4, 2004. In order to align demonstration periods with expenditure reporting requirements, we are modifying the end date of your demonstration. Your previous approval documents indicated that the demonstration would expire on November 3, 2009. Your new demonstration expiration date is November 30, 2009 to allow expenditure reporting through the full month of November.

The approval of the demonstration, as referenced in the State's award letter, continues to be contingent upon the State's continued compliance with the demonstration Special Terms and Conditions (STCs).
